Hi Sir,

The transport configured King Air that was meant to be transporting CDF to WB is now **unserviceable** and now the CDF will be travelling in a podded frame (only 4 seats).

They are expecting the transport aircraft to be serviceable later this morning but too late for CDF flight. It is likely to be too late for any possible flight into Napier for the PM.

The King Air can't land in Wairoa. We are looking into if a Herc can.

Following your phone call just now **s.** 6(a) we will scope options for King Air (preference transport airframe, second option podded with pax limits) to be positioned in Napier this afternoon for PM.

Hi Sir/all,

I have just spoken with SCE on this.

CDF has asked me to confirm:

- What the specific support request was for? I understand this to have been directly for an NH-90 for a specific leg of flight?
- 2. That Wairoa is an unsuitable airfield to have offered a fixed wing aircraft out of?
- 3. If Wairoa is unsuitable, was there any consideration or offer of providing a fixed wing aircraft out of Napier that would remove the requirement for the PM programmes to be dictated by the Air NZ Schedule?

Possible follow up: At this point, CDF does not intend to change the schedule or offer new options as changing plans can be just as difficult as making them. However, he has suggested that if it helps PMO that if the Kingair can drop him in Woodbourne this morning then he would be happy for that aircraft to be re-tasked to support the PM out of Napier and that may allow the PM to have a full programme in Wairoa without being constrained by the AIR NZ scheduled departure times out of Napier.
