I refer to your email of 5 February 2025 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), the following information about the recent C-130H Hercules farewell Flight:

Could you please provide a breakdown of the costs for this tour, including, but not limited to:

- the fuel cost;
- the man hour cost;
- maintenance costs, if any.

The farewell tour of the New Zealand Defence Force's (NZDF) C-130H Hercules aircraft was flown by three aircraft, over 3 and 4 February 2025. The total flying time accumulated was 25.8 hours, and cost approximately \$292,300. This figure is determined using the hourly short term tasking cost for the C-130H Hercules for Financial Year 2024/25. This includes marginal personnel costs, fuel, airport charges and other associated costs in relation to the flight. Short-term tasking rates do not include workshop maintenance, personnel salaries, depreciation and capital charge. A further breakdown of this cost is not available.
