I refer to your email of 7 March 2025 to Hon Judith Collins KC, Minister of Defence, requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) the following information:

- 1. May I respectfully request a written copy of the unembiguous policy decision by the Government of the day on the deployment of NZ Forces to South East Asia.
- 2. I further request a written copy of the independent Ministerial Review by the Chief Of Defense regarding the service in South East Asia up to 31 December 1974.

Your request was transferred to the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) for response in accordance with the OIA.

With respect to your request for a written copy of the unembiguous policy decision by the Government of the day on the deployment of NZ Forces to South East Asia, the letter you received from Hon Judith Collins on 6 March 2025 stated the following: The 31 January 1974 cutoff date for the New Zealand Operational Service Medal is because it marked the effective date of an unambiguous policy decision by the Government on the deployment of New Zealand forces in the region. The policy decision is the establishment of NZFORSEA from this date. There is a large amount of supporting information that is publicly available at Archives New Zealand and the National Library.
