I refer to your email of 8 July 2025 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), information regarding the current status of retired AUG rifles as it relates to possible export to the USA in the form of demilled [sic] parts kits?

The STEYR AUG rifle was withdrawn from service in 2018. Originally, the Minister of Defence approved potential resale and/or reuse of some of the rifles but, following the Christchurch terror attack in March 2019, the decision to destroy the majority of the rifles was taken. 36 variants/rifles were retained for military heritage purposes (service museums and NZ Police) and the remaining stocks were destroyed. The New Zealand Defence Force has no plans to export retired AUG rifle parts to the USA.
