I refer to your email of 17 July 2025 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), ...the total number of arrests made by military police in New Zealand between January 2021 and 25 March 2022. Please include a breakdown of the types of offenses that resulted in these arrests, the locations where these arrests took place, and any relevant documents or correspondence related to this request.

NZDF Military Police made eight arrests between 1 January 2021 and 25 March 2022. The below table sets out the location and charge for each arrest.
